Reimagining the Role of Teachers:

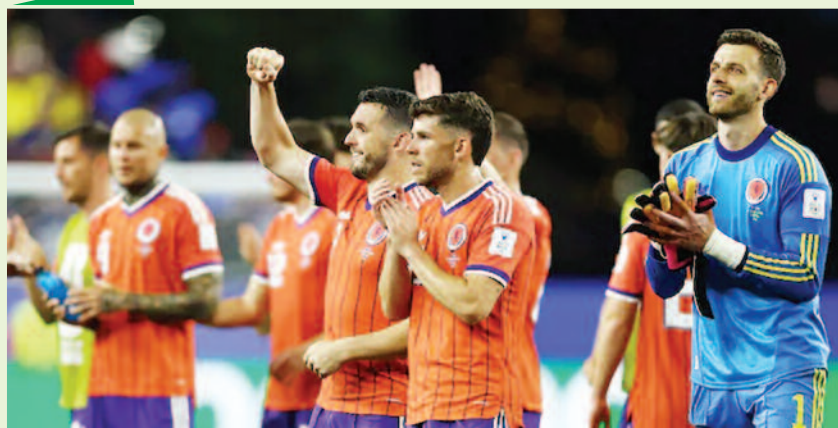
