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QUAD NATIONS HOLD STRATEGIC MEETING IN NEW DELHI

Foreign ministers of India, the United States, Japan, and Australia gathered in New Delhi for an important Quad meeting aimed at strengthening cooperation in the Indo-Pacific region. The leaders discussed regional security, maritime safety, economic partnerships, cyber security, and emerging technologies. India emphasised the importance of maintaining a free, open, and inclusive Indo-Pacific region. Climate change, clean energy cooperation, disaster management, and infrastructure development were also major topics during the discussions. 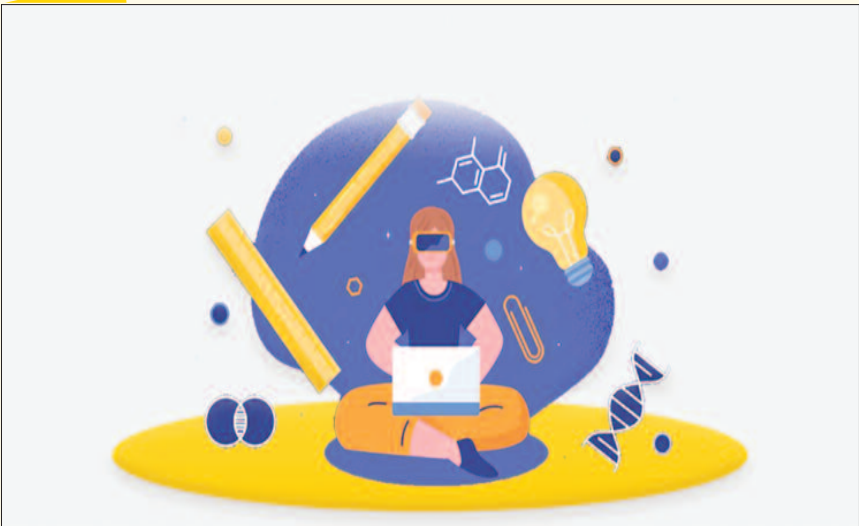


EUROPE TO HOST REUTERS NEXT LEADERSHIP SUMMIT

TWISHA DEATH CASE:
RETIRED JUDGE GIRIBALA
SINGH ARRESTED BY CBI

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Thursday (May 28, 2026) arrested retired Bhopal district judge Giribala Singh in the Twisha Sharma dowry harassment and death case, a day after the Madhya Pradesh High Court rejected the anticipatory bail a local court had granted her on May 15. Ms. Singh, Twisha’s mother-in-law, was questioned for six hours at her house in Bhopal before the arrest, the agency’s Chief Information Officer Beena Yadav told The Hindu. On Thursday morning, several CBI officers arrived at Ms. Singh’s residence and carried out an investigation and recreated the crime scene.



U.S.-IRAN AGREE ON 60-DAY
CEASEFIRE EXTENSION, BUT
TRUMP MUST APPROVE

Earlier, the U.S. military on Thursday (May 28, 2026) slammed Iran for violating a fragile ceasefire after Kuwait reported coming under attack in the latest flare-up that threatened ongoing negotiations to end the war. U.S. Central Command said that Kuwait had intercepted missiles launched by Iran late on Wednesday (May 27) night, calling the Iranian attack on one of America’s top allies in the Persian Gulf an “egregious ceasefire violation.” The U.S. and Iran have traded strikes throughout the week, even as President Donald Trump has said he’s confident his administration is making headway in negotiations with Iran to end the war.

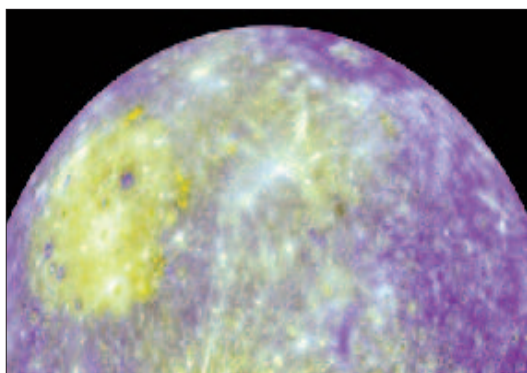
HEAVY RAIN, THUNDERSTORM IN
DELHI, PARTS OF NCR, BRING
RESPIRE FROM INTENSE HEAT

Heavy rain and thunderstorms swept across Delhi and parts of the NCR on Thursday, bringing much-needed relief from the intense heatwave conditions that had gripped the region over the past few days. Strong winds, lightning and showers led to a significant drop in temperatures, offering respite to residents struggling with soaring mercury levels. According to India Meteorological Department (IMD), another spell of light to moderate rainfall, with intensity reaching up to 10 mm per hour at many places and isolated intense spells of 10-15 mm per hour, is likely to affect Delhi after an hour and continue over the subsequent 1-2 hours. "Another spell of light to moderate rainfall (upto 10mm/hr) at many places with intense spell (10-15mm/hr) at isolated places accompanied with Thunderstorm/Lightning/Strong Winds (50-60 gusting to 70 kmph) at many places and Hailstorm at isolated places is likely after an hour over Delhi during subsequent 1-2 hour," the weather department wrote.



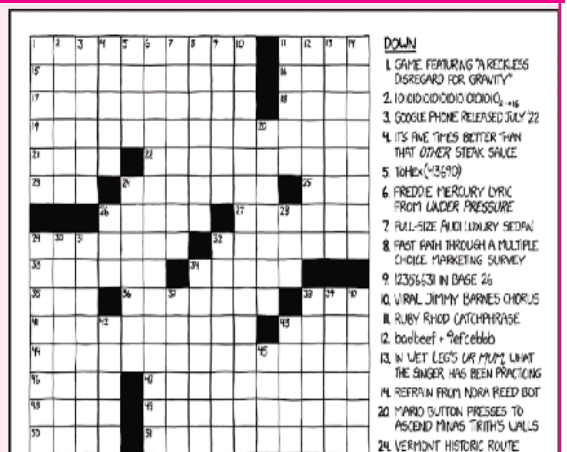
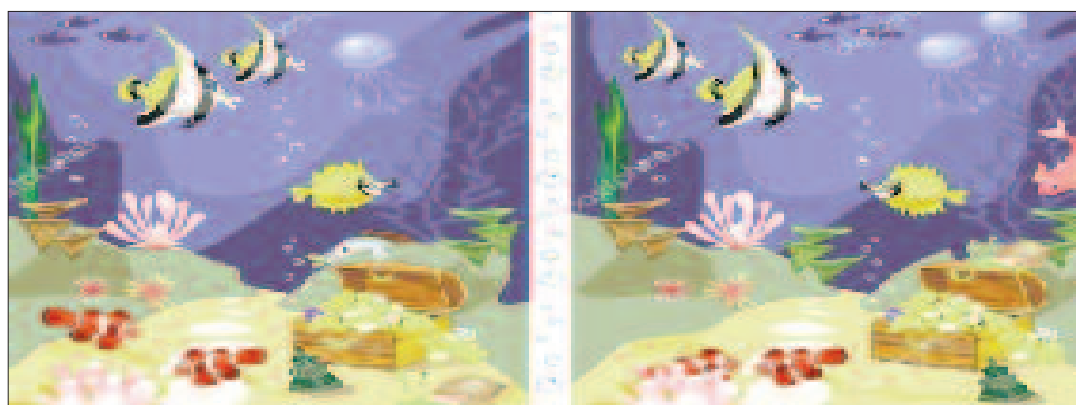
