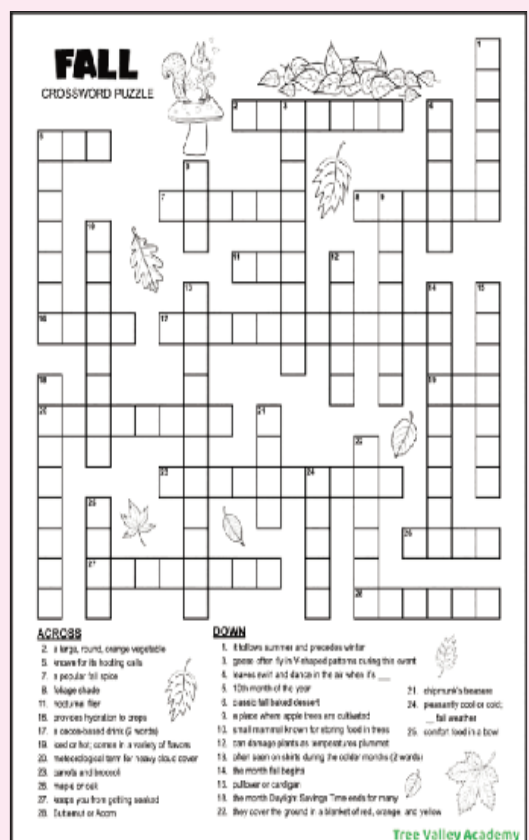

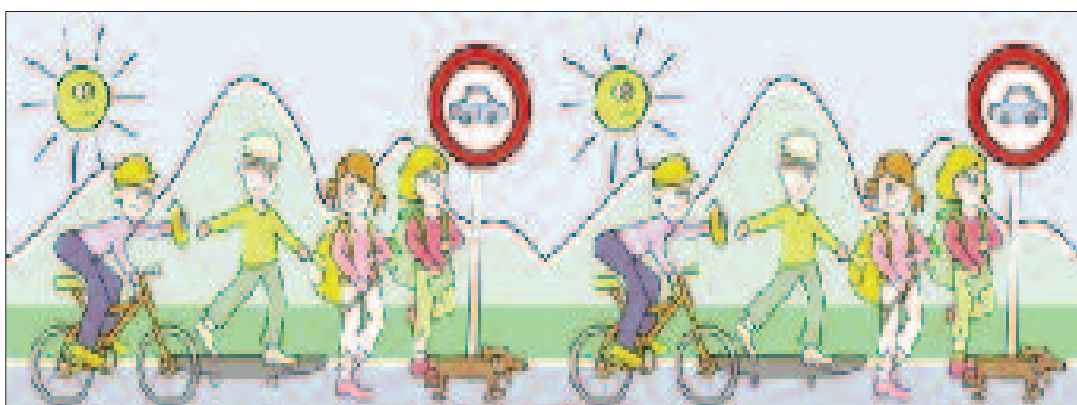

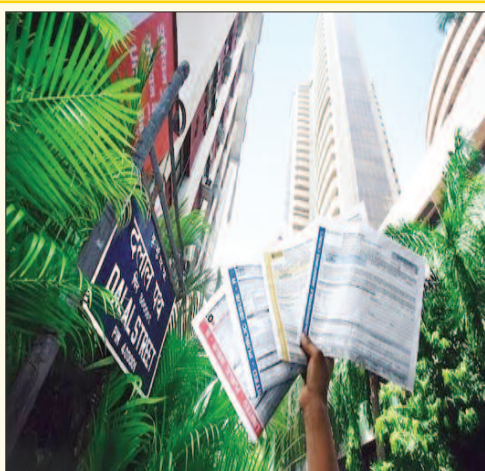

META APOLOGISES AFTER PM MODI'S VIDEO IS REMOVED BY MISTAKE

Meta has apologised after a video featuring Prime Minister Narendra Modi was mistakenly removed from its platform, triggering criticism from lawmakers and raising fresh concerns about content moderation. The company clarified that the removal was caused by a technical error and not by any deliberate action. The video was restored shortly after the issue was identified. The matter came under discussion before a Parliamentary Standing Committee, where Members of Parliament sought greater accountability from global technology companies. They stressed that social media platforms play an important role in public communication and must ensure transparency while moderating content related to national leaders and public institutions. Meta representatives expressed regret over the incident and assured the committee that measures are being taken to strengthen internal systems and prevent similar errors in the future. The company reiterated its commitment to maintaining a safe and reliable platform while respecting freedom of expression. The episode has once again highlighted the growing debate over the role of artificial intelligence and automated systems in content moderation.



SENSEX SURGES AS INVESTORS CHEER POSITIVE MARKET

Indian stock markets witnessed a strong rally on Monday as the BSE Sensex gained over 500 points while the NSE Nifty crossed a key milestone. Positive global cues, stable crude oil prices and renewed foreign investor interest contributed to the market's impressive performance. Banking, information technology and automobile stocks led the gains, while investors remained optimistic ahead of important economic announcements expected later this week.
