upcoming portal will incorporate a biometric attendance system. Doctors will be required to register their attendance by punching in once every 24 hours upon entering or leaving the hospital. Notably, the NMC has consistently advocated for the adoption of the Aadhaar-enabled biometric attendance system (AEBAS) in medical colleges.



- 8. Your paper octopus is ready!






